Must be accepted to a four year college with a minimum 3.25 GPA. Specific requirements outlined online.

You will need proof of blindness, academic achievement, 3-letters of recommendation, and 2- personal statements.

Must have a 3.0 GPA, leadership experience and financial need.
National Federation for the Blind	https://nfb.org/scholarships	March	\$3,000 - \$12,000	Scholarships for seniors and college students who are blind or visually impaired. You will need to attend a week-long NFB conference if awarded a scholarship. You need 2 letters of recommendation, proof of blindness, and an Affiliate President's letter. To receive this, go online to find the Federation Affiliate President's contact information.
