Students applying for the Academic Merit Award must meet all of the following requirements:

- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.8 or higher
- 9th Grade: Transcript reflects at least four Honors academic core (Math, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies and World Language) classes taken in 9th grade.
- 10th 12th Grade: A total of 12 Honors, AP or Concurrent academic core classes taken during sophomore through senior years which come from the Advanced Course list below.
- 9th 12th Grade: A grade of "B" or higher reflected on your transcript in each of the qualifying core classes (any grade of B- will disqualify the applicant).
