WHAT DOES A TECHNICIAN DO

As a technician you will be monitoring computer controlled systems within a industrial or commerical facility to maximize efficiency.

THE PROGRAM

As the state's only Building Automation Systems (BAS) certificate program, Salt Lake Technical College prepares you to make buildings more efficient. Training in BAS is a skills step-up for people in building maintenance, HVAC professionals, and existing BAS technicians.

FUNDING

If you are new to the industry you may qualify to have your tuition 100% covered through the Johnson Controls (JCI) grant. Or if you are looking to continue your education in the field you may qualify for 50% tuition coverage through STIT.

INTERNSHIP/EXTERNSHIP CAPSTONE

If you receive JCI funding you will participate with an internship at JCI or another employer. All others will participate in an externship or a research project at their own company.
